The weight classes of the **newcomer category** and the **advanced category** as well as the Open Class (BJJ and Submission Wrestling) will be held as a single elimination tournament. In case of a draw (by points) there will be an additional 2-minute-round with '**golden point**' (the first fighter who scores a point during this time wins the fight).

Weight Category Newcomer (BJJ and Submission Wrestling)

Men: -67kg, -77kg, -87kg, -97kg, +97kg

Women: -60kg, +60kg

Timelimit: 5 minutes with ,golden point' in case of a draw

Weight Category Advanced (BJJ and Submission Wrestling)

Men: -67kg, -77kg, -87kg, -97kg, +97kg

Women: -60kg, +60kg

Timelimit: 7 minutes with ,golden point' in case of a draw

Open Class (BJJ)

Open Class (Submission Wrestling)

Prize money: 100,- Euro for the winner

Timelimit: 5 minutes with ,golden point' in case of a draw

Rules (Newcomer)

Illegal techniques

- striking and kicking of any kind
- biting, pulling hair etc.
- ‚closing the windpipe‘
- hands, knee or elbow in the face
- twisted footlocks/kneelocks, fingerlocks
- slamming the opponent (bastaca)
- neckcranks
- any kind of action (armlocks, footlocks, chokes) that does not give the opponent time to tap

Legal techniques:

- any kind of throws and takedowns where the opponent does not land on the neck/head
- straight footlocks/kneelocks
- arm- and wristlocks
- chokes (with and without gi)

Rules (Advanced)

Illegal techniques:

- same as in the newcomer category, except neckcranks
- neckcrank as a takedown (kruzifix)
- twisted neckcranks

Legal techniques:

- same as in the newcomer category
- straight neckcranks

Points

Mount/Backmount:	4 points
Passing the Guard:	3 points
Knee on Belly:	2 points
Sweep:	2 points
Takedown:	2 points

To get the points a position has to be controlled at least 3 seconds (except throws). After passing the guard the opponent has to be controlled 3 seconds as well in order to collect the points.

An advantage is awarded if an action (takedown, passing the guard, sweep or submission) is almost completed.

Decision

- by tapping (with hands/feet or verbally)
- by points
- by advantage
- by 'golden point' during the additional 2 minutes of a fight (in case of a draw)
- by referees decision (in case of a draw after the additional time)
- by disqualification

Timelimit

Fight time is 5 minutes in the newcomer category and 7 minutes in the advanced category. In case of a draw there will be an additional 2 minutes with the chance to end the fight by 'golden point'. If the additional time does not evolve a winner the fight ends by referees decision.

Important!

Misbehaviour towards fighters and/or referees will not be tolerated and end in a disqualification from the tournament.
